Once again we have the three flights. These points are as of the June master point cycle.

A - OPEN

B - 0-2000

C - 0-500 NONLIFE MASTER

NEW AND IMPROVED NORTH AMERICAN PAIRS!!

Club sanction fees now are only \$4 per table

More games!! Clubs may hold two qualifying games per month per sanctioned sessions

In June, July and August

There is no requirement to hold Unit Finals

However Unit Finals can be held.

A single session awards red points only

For two or more session Unit Finals Masterpoints are 20% gold, 80% red for Flight A; 10% gold, 90% red for flight B and 5% gold, 95% red for non life master flight.

A SANCTION IS NECESSARY FOR UNIT FINALS

A sanction application must be submitted to ACBL Headquarters for each Unit Final.

North American Pairs. Complete the applications and submit.

B. Your application will come to the Special Events Department via email.

C. Your submission will be acknowledged and copied to your District coordinator who Can approve it or inform you of any objections.

In general to be eligible for the District stage

A) If there is a unit stage -- a player must have qualified at the club stage and at the unit stage

B) If there is NO unit stage -- at the club stage.

IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE AT THE DISTRICT FINAL YOU MUST HAVE QUALIFIED AT A CLUB GAME OR A UNIT FINAL. ABSOLUTELY NO NON QUALIFIERS WILL BE ALLOWED TO PLAY IN THE FINALS!

THE DISTRICT FINAL WILL BE HELD ON SATURDAY OCTOBER 1st AT 1:00 P.M. DURING THE REGINA RED COAT REGIONAL.

ALERT: For all double session events in all three flights every pair will play every other pair at least once.
